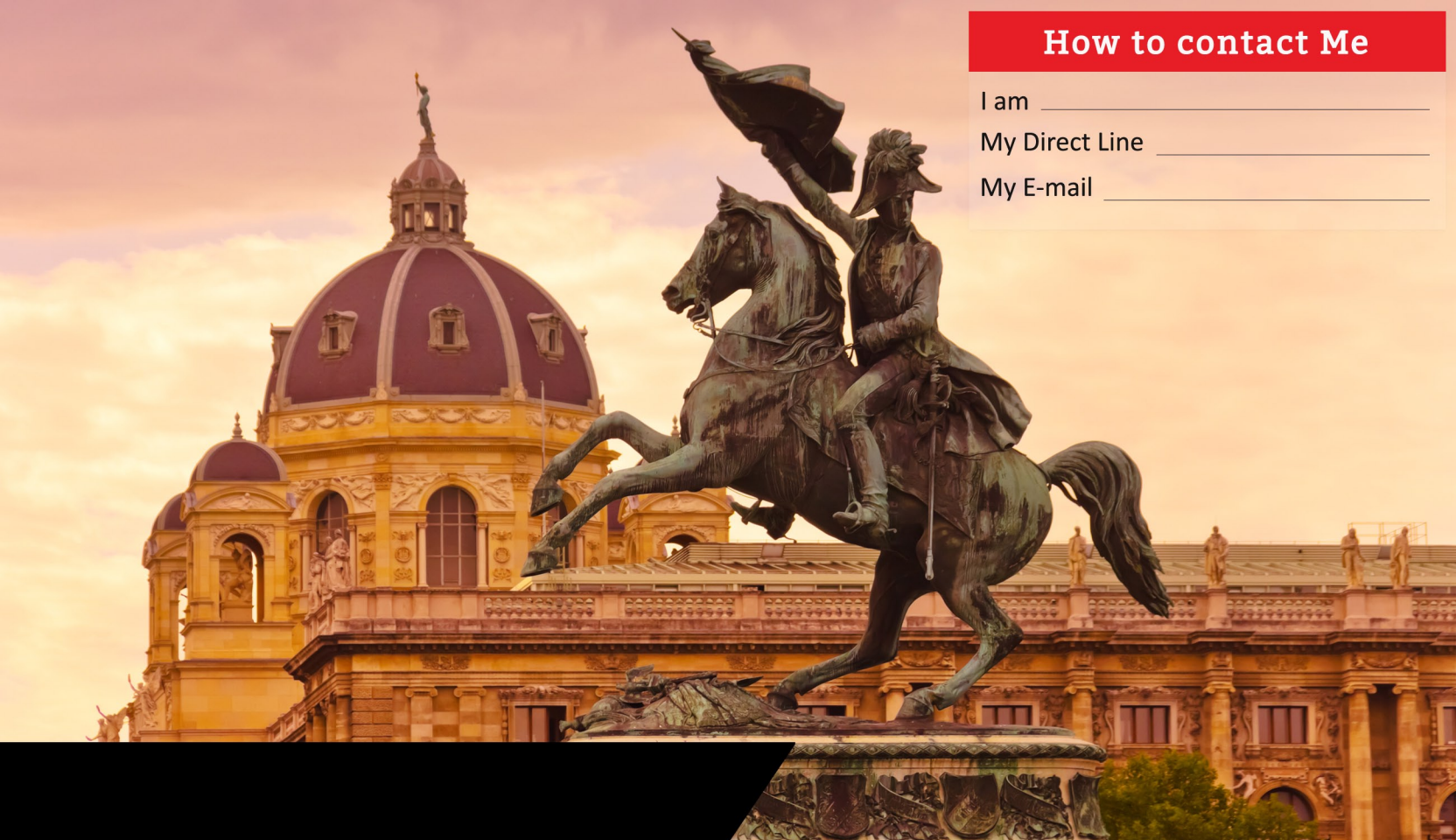

About Red-White-Red Card

- The Red White-Card is a new immigration initiative from the Austrian Government to encourage highly skilled migrants who apply to work and settle in Austria
- Very Highly Qualified Worker program is a point based scheme that allows you to work in Austria without a prior job offer. You are allowed to stay for 6 months without a job offer
- The Red White card will be issued for 12 months after finding a job which is relevant to your qualifications. This will also allow you to take your spouse and children below 18 years of age. Your spouse can also obtain a RWR card plus and start working in Austria
- RWR card plus with a full labor market access can be secured after completing minimum of 10 months employment with the current employer, which further allows you to gain permanent residency after 5 years of residence status
- You can secure your citizenship after 5 years following your permanent residence status



Austria Overview

- Austria is one of the richest countries in the world, with a nominal per capita GDP of \$43,723. The country has developed a high standard of living and was ranked 25th in the world for its Human Development Index
- Vienna is the capital and largest city, with a population exceeding 1.6 million. It has been ranked the 2nd best city in the world to live in
- Austria is part of European Union (EU), it joined EU in the year 1995
- Austria is a landlocked country with roughly 8.4 million people in central Europe. It is bordered by the Czech Republic and Germany to the north, Slovakia and Hungary to the east, Slovenia and Italy to the south and Switzerland and Liechtenstein to the west
- The majority of the population speaks German, which is also the country's official language
- Today, Austria is a parliamentary representative democracy comprising nine federal states.

Austrian Economy

- Austria, with its well-developed market economy and high standard of living is closely tied to other EU economies, especially Germany
- Following several years of solid foreign demand for Austrian exports and record employment growth, the international financial crisis and global economic downturn resulted in Austrian economy slowing down for a brief period
- Austrian economy features a large service sector, a sound industrial sector, and a small, but highly developed agricultural sector
- Unemployment has not risen steeply in Austria as elsewhere in Europe, partly because its government offers many subsidies to various sectors



Indian Presence in Austria

- There are an estimated 12,000 Indians in Austria, a majority from Kerala working primarily in the health care and business sectors
- The Indian community as a percentage of a population of 8 million at around 12,000 is just 0.15%
- There are 3005 PIOs and 8940 NRIs residing in Austria
- Early Indian immigrants to Austria were mainly nurses from Kerala. There is a small community from rural Punjab, whose members graduated from odd jobs to later become successful entrepreneurs
- There have been over 500 business collaborations (including over 100 technological and over 60 involving financial participation, representation offices) between India and Austria

Who are eligible?

- Very highly qualified workers, who are at a managerial level or with relevant qualifications and extensive experience and a commitment to work and settle in Austria. This is a point based category and applicant must meet at least 70 out of 100 points on various criteria's such as Age / Work Experience/ Qualifications / Language Skills / Adaptability (Education from Austria). A six months visa will be granted to search for jobs in Austria and obtain a RWR card with an employment offer. This is only for the category for applicants who do not have a ready job offer in hand.
- Other Key Workers - Foreign citizens who are ready to take up an employment with a company in Austria (job offer required) as a key worker based on their qualifications, can apply under this category. This is a point based category and the applicant must secure 50 out of maximum points 75.
- RWR card for 12 months is granted to work with the employer.
- Graduates of universities and colleges of higher education in Austria. This category is for students who graduated and completed a part of education in Austria at a College or University level and have a Job offer relevant to their education.

Requirements

Education/Skills

Hold University Qualifications including Bachelors, Masters Degree or PhD for a minimum duration of 4 years in line to the nominated occupation, which is at a managerial level.

Sufficient funds

Hold sufficient funds for the intended stay in Austria which is required at the time of application.

Language

Applicants should have basic level language skills in German (A2) or English (IELTS or TOEFL) to work in the nominated occupation.

Age

Between 18 - 45 to secure points

Sign up for a PRR to check if you are eligible for Austria

The highly qualified worker program is a point based scheme that allows you to search an employment in Austria.

After finding a job:

The RWR card will be issued for 12 months after finding a job which is relevant to your qualification. This will also allows you to take your spouse and children below 18. Your spouse can obtain a RWR Card Plus and start working in Austria.

After completing 10 months with current employer:

RWR card plus with complete labor market access can be secured after completing at least 10 months with the current employer.

After 5 years of Residence Status:

Secure Permanent Residency in Austria.

After 5 years of PR:

You can apply for Austrian Citizenship after 5 year, following your Permanent Residence Status.
